MINUTES OF MEETING

15.61 The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 12th May 2015 were before the meeting and signed as a correct record.

15.63 Chairman's Report

12th May

Parish Council meeting.

13th May

Roger Gomm, Neville Chuck and the Chairman attended a Neighbourhood Planning Forum at Buntingford. Concern was expressed that the yet to be funded Buntingford traffic plan (The Phoenix Project) should not be confused with the Neighbourhood Plan.

15th June

Cllr Rose Cheswright came to Cottered and inspected the drainage problem at the crossroads of the B1037 and Warren Lane. Rose and the Chairman walked down Peasecroft and discussed possible options for improving the parking problems.

29 June

The track forming the access to 40, 41 and 42 The Crescent was finally improved by the housing association.

Roger Gomm, Neville Chuck and the Chairman attended a Neighbourhood Planning Forum A resident from Parkside had asked if his property and its surrounding land could be designated for the development of a number of bungalows. After consultation with Cottered and Throcking Parish Councillors and an appropriate Buntingford representative it was decided that the Neighbourhood Plan would not be the place to promote individual housing development sites.

There was no objection by the Parish Council to this application.

15.68 East Herts District Plan and Neighbourhood Plan

Parkside Development

Council concluded that the development of this land should go through the normal channels by submitting plans to East Herts District Council. Council felt that the Buntingford Community Area Neighbourhood Plan would not be the place to promote a specific site, rather the aim of the Neighbourhood Plan is to set out local policies which will then be used by East Herts Council, along with other national and district policies, in determining the applications that are put before them.

15.69 **Telephone Box**

The Clerk reported that we did not qualify for free paint to repaint the telephone box in Cottered; free paint could only be obtained if a defibrillator had been ordered through Community Heartbeat. Telephone box replacement parts and paint can be obtained from a number of suppliers. X2 Connect Kiosk Spares supply a complete Paint Kit (Red, black, white paint, undercoat and accessories) for £119.00 or individually ie.2.5 litres of Currant (red) Gloss costing £40.08.

The Clerk is to compile a list of the required repairs to the telephone box, cost those repairs and obtain quotes to get those repairs carried out.

15.70 The Old Barn and Village Green

This issue will be discussed at the next Parish Trust meeting on Tuesday 28th July at 7.30pm in Cottered Village Hall.

HIGHWAYS

15.71 **Peascroft**

Councillors discussed a number of items relating to both Peascroft and The Crescent.

It was thought the problem of cars driving across the green had been dealt with by the Police.

Parking was still an issue and various suggestions had been considered from having a single yellow line to opening up the green at the end of Peascroft and making The Crescent and Peascroft one way.

Concern was raised about the junction of The Crescent and Peascroft with the A507 Baldock Road. It was considered this was a dangerous junction and there had been a number of 'near misses' especially with cars turning right towards Buntingford. Vehicles leaving Cottered are accelerating as they leave the 30mph limit and the signage showing a right hand turning is obscured by overgrown trees.

The hedges outside number 4, 19 and 20 have grown considerably and are obscuring a clear view of the A507 for vehicles turning out of The Crescent.

The Clerk will contact Highways and Circle Anglia with a view to getting the trees and hedges outside the houses concerned cut back.

LITTER

15.72 Litter Bins

3 of the 5 of the new litter bins have been secured. The one at the Guide Centre needs to be slightly relocated as it hasn't been possible to remove the old one and replace with the new one on the same site. There has been some dispute as to where to place the one at the bottom of Peascroft; residents had reported being able to smell the contents so it was suggested the new bin should be relocated further from the properties.

RECREATION GROUND

15.73 Repair/replace tractor

Resolved: Council unanimously agreed to purchase the tractor, currently being hired to the Council by Brian Murchie, to cut the Recreation Ground grass.

The Clerk will contact Brian Murchie to organise the sale, deal with necessary paperwork and insure the vehicle.

Complaints had been heard about grass being deposited on paths after the contractors had carried out their regular grass cutting visits.

The resident stated that the grass outside the Old Barn was not being cut as part of the contractors designated areas. It was thought there was a history of problems with this area due to flints falling from the wall and being hazardous to the grass cutting machinery. The resident had spoken to Councillor Pitman who had agreed to look into it.

In Cottered cars were being parked on pavements and totally obscuring the footpath. It was felt residents needed reminding not to do this and the best way to get the message out to the community was through the Cottered and Throcking News. The Clerk would contact the Editor with a view to having this message included in the next issue.

The sign on the A507/B1037 stating it was unsuitable for HGVs was being obscured by trees. The Clerk would investigate and inform Highways.
