The figure now provided includes all ASB – environmental, nuisance and personal.

Please note that there has been a change in the way burglary offences are recorded nationally. They are now classified as:

Burglary Residential – all buildings within the boundaries of a property, including sheds and garages

Burglary Business and Community – buildings that are solely for business purposes or are otherwise outside the classification of residential burglary, such as a sports club or place of worship.

Details

There was one burglary this month at a remote property that was unoccupied. A number of people were arrested on the same night on suspicion of committing offences and investigations are under way.

Other News and events

- As the weather hots up (fingers crossed) and the evenings become much lighter, please be mindful of leaving house windows open when you are not at home or your car windows down, as this leaves your property vulnerable. If you are out in the garden remember to keep any doors you are not insight of locked and try to keep your side gates locked too.
